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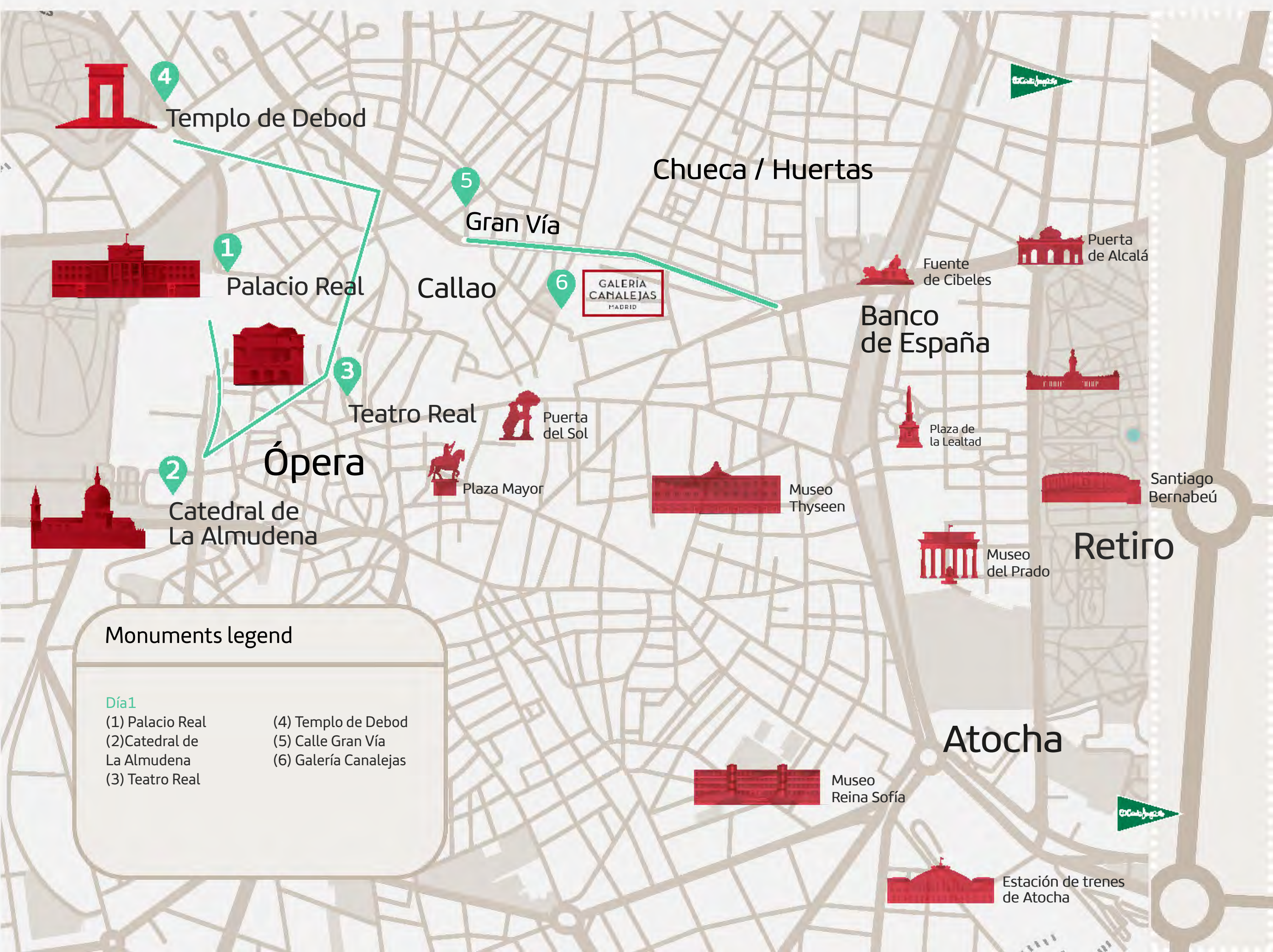
Stopover Hola Madrid 3-day route

Day 1 of 3

Morning: Start the day with a visit to **Madrid's Royal Palace (1)**, one of the most emblematic places in the city, located next to the **Almudena Cathedral (2)**. 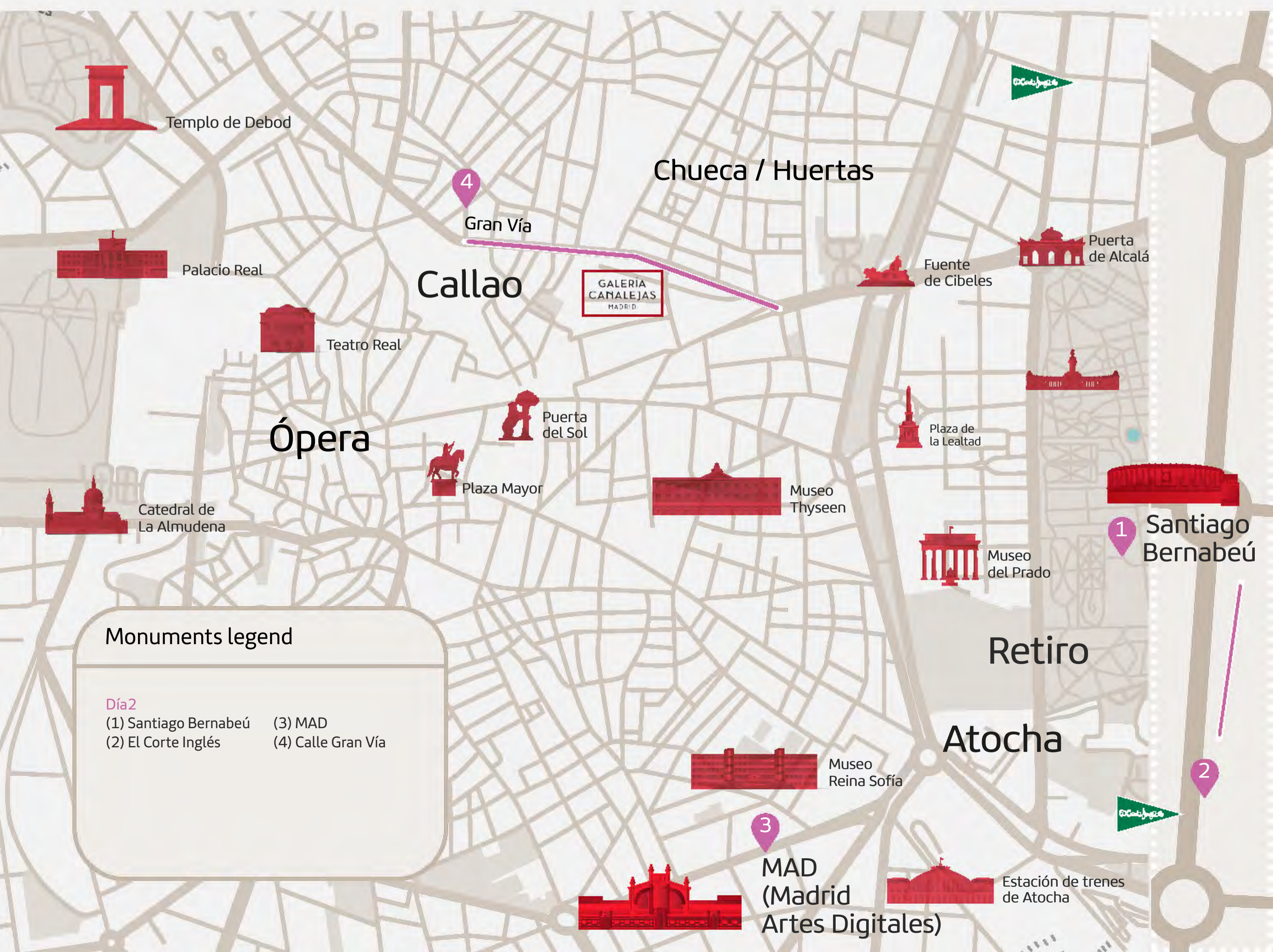
Day 2 of 3

Day 3 of 3

You can also visit the **Museo Reina Sofía (4)**, home to works by Dalí and Picasso.

Night: Head to Plaza de Santa Ana or the Barrio de Huertas, famous for its vibrant nightlife. You'll find live music, cocktails and tapas in any of the local bars. Take advantage of another discount and book tickets for one of the top musicals.
